- 1. Academic Support Program for Student-Athletes, NC State Student Code of Conduct, NC State Student-Athlete Code of Conduct and NCAA rules must be followed at all times.
- 2. Tutor, study hall and computer lab areas are only to be used for academic purposes by student-athletes. ASPSA staff reserves the right to designate and assign study areas.
- 3. Students must sign-in and out when using academic areas (computer lab, tutor rooms, or quiet study areas). It is your responsibility to accurately sign-in and out.
- 4. Respect all full-time and part-time ASPSA staff.
- 5. No food, drink, or tobacco products are allowed in the study or computer areas (water bottles and light snacks are allowed).
- 6. Blinds must be open and lights must be on at all times (unless approved by an ASPSA staff member).
- 7. No cell phone usage allowed in the study or computer areas.
- 8. Refrain from disruptive behavior. Case is an academic center where students come to work quietly.
- 9. Computer use, personal or university owned, is for academic purposes only.
 All computer screens must face the door in the tutoring rooms and study areas.
- 10. Collaboration on academic assignments can only occur if prior approval is granted by an ASPSA staff member.
